## 7/7 **Newport, Rhode Island**

This tony seaside resort town in [New England](#) kicks off summer with a back-to-back schedule of events. The [International Polo Series](#) is a Saturday mainstay during the warmer months, headquartered at Newport Polo, while the three-day long [Metre Fest](#) regatta lures a slew of sleek sailing yachts to the harbor. Lazier luxe-lovers can opt for the [Flower Show](#) at the Gilded Age mansion of Rosecliff, or chow down on the very best of New England Chowder during a [cook-off](#) at Fort Adams. Whatever appeals, book a room at [Gurneys](#), a [sister spot](#) to the Hamptons resort located on a 10-acre waterfront patch on Goat Island.
