But Gurney's stands apart most for its coastal edge: 2,000 feet of private access Atlantic, an unparalleled stretch of wedding weekend setting.

Inspector Notes: The Beach Club on the premises makes it easy to relax, with king-sized daybeds, beach chairs, and all the warm-weather cocktails you need. And if you prefer to swim in a pool instead of an ocean, Gurney's indoor pool — the only one of its kind on the continent — uses local seawater that's sand-filtered and warmed to the perfect temperature.
